




Job openings spike as job application activity slowly rises







Double digit growth in applicants to Hospitality jobs; Growth of applicants to Health Services and Retail jobs not far behind




Applicant Behavior Across Industries

Application activity down near 17% since 2019, and down about 8% since the start of this year




Manufacturing Job Applications Activity



Significant growth in manufacturing openings

Openings for production occupations in the manufacturing industry are up 61% since the start of Q1 2019, and 36% since the start of Q1 2021.

Steady uptick in hiring despite labor shortages

Hires of production occupations and other roles up 62% and 8% since Q1 2019, and 10% and 27% respectively, since the start of 2021




Manufacturing Hiring Activity
